The Anchorage, Alaska native joined the Bulls this past season after spending the 2019-20 season with goaltender Alex Houston and Forward Rocco Testa-Basi at the prestigious USHS Prep School, Gilmour Academy. King is the second Bull selected in an NAHL draft this summer.
